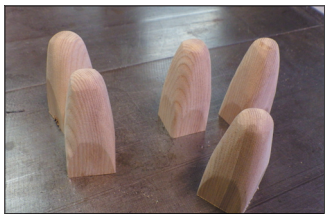


Perfect Stripping Basket

1. Go to IKEA and buy a child's step stool...\$4.99

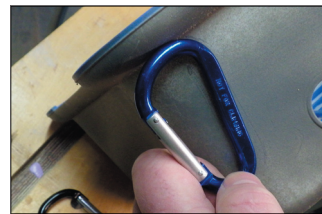
2. Paint the outside or cover with duct tape. I think the white is too bright. If you use gray, some will mistake it for the 85 dollar Orvis model- http://www.orvis.com/store/product.aspx?pf_id=1433



3. Figure out some way to put in the cones, weed-wacker cord, heavy mono, etc. to keep your line from sloshing around in the bucket. I used wood shaped on my belt sander. You could use peices of dowel, broomstick or what have you, as long as they are smooth. Internet is full of ideas for this.



4. Attach cheap (\$1.00) carabiners to the sides of the basket. I used wire ties. Better to make holes with a soldering iron or hot nail. Hole will be stronger.



5. Use a wading belt to attach unit to your waist. Done....total cost- app\$ 10 bucks.
